### Class Newsletter Spring Term 2026

We are very excited to introduce our new learning adventure! This term, our learning will centre on the big question 'What is out there?'—a theme designed to spark children's curiosity about themselves, their community and the wider world. Through real and imagined contexts linked to homes, families, travel, countries and holidays, the children will explore identity and belonging while beginning to understand places within and beyond their own locality.

Our learning will continue to be cross-curricular, practical and hands-on, with a strong focus on developing children's problem-solving, thinking skills, creativity and independence. The children will once again help shape the learning through their own 'I wonder...' questions, giving them ownership, increasing engagement and ensuring the learning remains meaningful to them.

By the end of this term, the children will have deepened their sense of who they are, where they belong and how they fit into the wider world—They would also have experienced lots of creative and fun learning adventures too!

#### Language, Literacy and Communication

The children will read a range of books daily in class. Every day, we will practice high frequency words and phonics from the Monster Phonics programme. <https://monsterphonics.com/phonics-support-for-parents/> Please listen to your child read and practise the unit words. We will also practise these words with your child in school and new units of words will be sent home when required. Please sign the record and make a comment if you wish.

Some useful apps are as follows:

**Hairy Letters**-Games to reinforce learning and build letters into simple words, the Hairy characters and memorable animations make this a fun and engaging introduction to literacy.

**Hairy Phonics**- Introduces the digraphs that every child needs to learn. Two vowels join together and make one sound

#### **Dosbarth Melyn**

Reading books will be sent home every day. Please ensure that the book and book bag are returned to school.

#### **Dosbarth Coch**

Reading books will be sent home on a Friday. Please ensure that the book and book bag are returned to school on a Monday. Thank You!

#### **Dosbarth Melyn**

Weekly spelling patterns will be placed on Seesaw. We will practise these spelling and phonics daily in class. Please practise these words at home in preparation for the weekly challenge on a Friday. Some learners will have access to the Nessy programme to help with reading, spelling and writing. The children will practice Nessy for 20 minutes daily in school as part of our daily reading carousel.

#### **Dosbarth Coch**

Weekly spelling patterns will be placed in the children's individual reading record. We will practise these spelling and phonics daily in class. Please practise these words at home in preparation for the weekly challenge.

#### Mathematics and Numeracy

The children will be learning the following:

#### **Dosbarth Coch**

Revising Autumn Learn Its and learning new facts: 4+2, 5+2, 6+2, 7+2, 4+3, 5+3, 6+3

Counting: 60-69, 11-20, and counting in 2s, 3s, 4s, 5s, doubling numbers to 5 and doubling multiples of 10

Solving simple addition/subtraction and finding missing numbers to 10

Sharing even numbers between 2, fractions: halves, quarters, thirds

#### **Dosbarth Melyn**

New Learn Its: 5+4, 5+6, 6+7, 8+7, 8+9, and 5x & 10x tables

Counting past 100, partitioning 2-digit number, Counting in 2s, and in 10s, 20s, 50s, 100s and simple fractions

Doubling to 20, doubling multiples of 10, and knowing halves of 30, 50, 70, 90

Adding/subtracting 1 and 10, and taking away in tens, introduction to multiplication and division

## **Mathematics and Numeracy**

On Fridays the children will complete a CLIC, SAFE (**Dosbarth Melyn Only**) and Learn It Challenge with the number facts and skills we have been learning. The aim of the Learn It challenges is for the children to memorise the number facts and know the answers off by heart.

### **What can you do to help at home?**

Encourage your child to practise their times tables.

### **Woodland Sessions**
