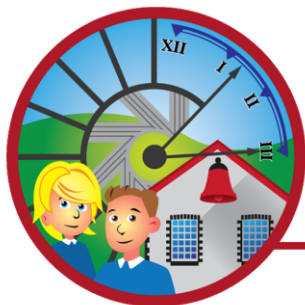

We are saying a fond farewell to Mrs Langdon who has been a valued member of staff for many years. She is venturing out into a new career and starts a new job today, we thank her for all her dedication, hard work and fun she brought to everyone at Brynnau. Good luck Mrs Langdon! Replacing Mrs Langdon's Level 3 post is Miss Cale, we are delighted to have her taking on her new role in Reception with Miss Edwards from tomorrow.

As we move into the new academic year, we have set a new behaviour initiative which will be shared with children tomorrow. This is with a view to reward our wonderful children for all their efforts and achievements and deter any negative behaviours. The new initiative will be based around A, B, C points. Behaviours will be record daily on Bromcom by staff and will link to your child's MCAS account under 'Behaviour'. This will allow you to see all of their points and the reason they have been awarded. We are hoping to get this live within the next week or so.

- A- Awesome point (eg. Manners, effort, work, resilience, teamwork)
- B- Behaviour point (eg. Lack of respect, not listening, lack of effort with tasks)
- C- Consequence point (eg. Violence, vandalism, swearing, stealing)

The full Positive Relationships policy will be updated, shared with the Governing Body and sent to you before the MCAS Behaviour feature goes live. The policy will go through all rewards, consequences and procedures in detail. Awards will be given at the end of each term to celebrate those with fantastic A points, B points will be discussed with the child in school, C points will result in a phone call home from the class teacher on the day of the incident. Three C points in one term will action a letter requesting a meeting to discuss your child's behaviour with the Headteacher and loss of school trip privileges for the term. We are hoping the sharing of your child's behaviour points will allow you to praise and celebrate your child and when necessary, discuss and address negative behaviours at home.

We would love to see our children in Brynnau uniform each day, this does not need to have any school logo or badge. P.E days will be shared in your class newsletter next week and P.E kit continues to be school top with dark bottoms.

School timings are as follows,

- Gates open **8.50**

- Classroom doors open **8.55** (8.50 when raining)
- Nursery to Reception doors open just before **15.15** to allow handover of children. **Please be prompt collecting your child at the end of every school day.**
- Year 3 to Year 6 doors open just before **15.30**. **Please be prompt collecting your child at the end of every school day.**

We thank you for your continued support and welcome you to speak with your child's teacher at the end of the school day if needed. For significant issues, please make an appointment with the teacher via their HWB email which will be shared on class newsletters.
